Examination & Coursework Information:

iMedia is assessed using vocational grading, ie Level 1 or Level 2 Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction*. A single examination (**R081**) is taken in June 2022 covering aspects of pre-production of iMedia related products. The examination is heavily focussed on the theory of the coursework content.

Students have one remaining coursework module to complete:

- ***R083 Creating 2D/3D Characters*** is to be completed for submission in the new year.

The examination board are now allowing students to undertake their coursework at home. This will be vital to achieve high grades.

How you can support your child:

A quiet space to work and a regular routine for completing coursework are highly recommended. Staffed supervision at lunch on Monday, Wednesday and Friday in ICT5 is available (depending on which teaching group your son/daughter is in).

In order to achieve the best possible overall grade for their iMedia course we strongly recommend that students supplement their school-based learning by working at home on their projects on a regular basis, if they are not already doing so.
