Examination Information:

GCSE Art is assessed through students' coursework. Students' work is assessed against four objectives;

- 1. Making links with artists
- 2. Experimenting and refining work
- 3. Recording through drawing, painting and annotation
- 4. Personal response (originality)

All the work is marked holistically against all four assessment objectives and students need to have done enough work to fully cover all four.

The work done in Y10 is an important part of the coursework and is included with the Y11 work in the final marking.

All the work is teacher assessed. For the 2022 examination series, AQA have modified the GCSE and there will be no timed exam.

How you can support your child:

A quiet space to work and a regular routine for working at home are highly recommended. If you think that your child would benefit from staying at school to complete homework, there is a session on Monday and Thursday in A3 from 3.35-4.35pm. There is also an allocated quiet room at lunch every day in A3 for independent study.

In order to achieve the best possible overall grade for their Art GCSE we strongly recommend that students get into the habit of regular independent work from now onwards, if they are not already doing so. 30 minutes a couple of times a week or a one hour session once a week will significantly enhance their skills and confidence and build the necessary quantity of artwork. Student should continue with work started in lessons or draw or paint from their own photos on their current theme. They can also produce copies of the work of relevant artists found on the LMS Art Pinterest boards.
