Examination Information:

BTEC Engineering is assessed at Pass, Merit or Distinction (at both level 1 and level 2). There are 2 external examinations in February 2023 and 2 other units of work that are assessed internally that have been on-going since Year 10. There is still a large section of NEA (non-examined assessment) work to complete after the examination in February.

All students have been given a bespoke revision guide which gives vital and useful information on the examination structure and style of questions, as well as the relevant theory content.

All students will sit the external exams in February.

How you can support your child:

A quiet space to work and a regular routine for completing any independent work that may be set are highly recommended.

In order to achieve the best possible overall grade for their Engineering BTEC we strongly recommend that students get into the habit of regular revision from now onwards in the lead up to the examination in February, if they are not already doing so. Also, students should be very careful to read the assignment criteria within any of the assignment briefs that have been issued.
