Examination & Coursework Information:

Health and Social Care is assessed using vocational grading: Level 1 or Level 2 Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction*.

A single piece of coursework was taken (**R033**) in June 2024 covering areas of supporting individuals through life events.

A second piece of coursework is taken (**R035**) in February 2025 covering areas of health promotion campaigns.

Students will also have one examination module to complete in May 2025:

- **R032:** This covers the principles of health and social care settings.

How you can support your child:

A quiet space to work and a regular routine for completing coursework are highly recommended. Staffed supervision at lunch in ICT3 will be available.

In order to achieve the best possible overall grade for their health and social care course, we strongly recommend that students supplement their school-based learning by working at home on their coursework on a regular basis, if they are not already doing so.
