Examination & Coursework Information:

Sport Studies is assessed using vocational grading: Level 1 or Level 2 Pass, Merit, Distinction or Distinction*.

A single piece of coursework was taken (***R185 Performance and Leadership in Sport Activities***) in June 2024 covering areas of practical performance, organising and delivering a sports activity sessions and reviewing their performance.

A second piece of coursework is taken (***R186 Sport and the Media***) in February 2025 covering areas of media sources in sport and their positive and negative effects.

Students will also have one examination module to complete in May 2025:

- ***R184:*** This covers the principles of health and social care settings.

How you can support your child:

A quiet space to work and a regular routine for completing coursework are highly recommended. Staffed supervision at lunch in ICT3 will be available.

Sports Studies students have a specific drop-in session with a member of PE staff. This takes place in ICT3 on Fridays from 1.00-1.30.

In order to achieve the best possible overall grade for their Sports Studies course, we strongly recommend that students supplement their school-based learning by working at home on their coursework on a regular basis, if they are not already doing so.
