Examination Information:

GCSE D&T is assessed in a combination of Examination and a non-examined assessment (NEA). The examination carries 100 marks, is in 3 sections and is worth 50% of the GCSE:

Section A – Core technical principles (20 marks). This is a mixture of multiple choice and short answer questions assessing a breadth of technical knowledge and understanding.

Section B – Specialist technical principles (30 marks). There are several short answer questions (2–5 marks) and one extended response to assess a more in depth knowledge of technical principles.

Section C – Designing and making principles (50 marks). This is a mixture of short answer and extended response questions.

The NEA/ coursework is worth 50% of the GCSE. <u>Below are the important dates for the deadlines</u>. Students are invited back for catch-up sessions during <u>lunchtime</u> from September and <u>after school</u> starting in January.
