Chair's Report	- We started the year with the Silent Auction which raised just over £1700. - For the school play takings included £476 from the hamper raffles and £548 from the bar giving an excellent total of £1024. - The balloon race made £249 - Concerts in December in March provided £452 from the hamper raffle and £828 from the bar giving a total of £1280. - Car Boot Sales; May, Gate £170, Kitchen £326 Total £496 June, Gate £168, Kitchen £298 Total £466 - JT had another successful plant sale and donated £388 to the PTFA In summary, we have enjoyed a good year raising £5605 in total to date with 3 events to go. For a small band of parent warriors we have done brilliantly.
